## MINIMUM PERCENTAGES THAT NEED TO BE ACHIEVED in SENIOR PHASE

English – 50%

Afrikaans – 40%

Maths – 40%

Any other 3 subjects – 40%

Any other 2 subjects – 30%

CASS (Continuous assessment) – 40% of year mark

EXAMS – 60% of year mark

Please make sure your child has covered his/her books by Monday 29<sup>th</sup> January.

Your son/daughter has been issued text books for Maths, English and Afrikaans. These text books will need to be returned to the school at the end of the year, any missing books will incur a fine.
